

Regional COVID-19 Status Levels

STAY AT HOME:

All Virginians directed to stay at home except for allowable travel including:

- to seek medical attention
- work
- Care for family or household members
- obtain goods and services like groceries, prescriptions, and others as outlined in Executive Order Fifty-Three
- and engage in outdoor activity with strict social distancing requirements

PHASE I (TWO TO FOUR WEEKS)

- Some businesses re-open with strict safety restrictions
- Continued social distancing
- Continued teleworking
- Face coverings recommended in public

PHASE II (TWO TO FOUR WEEKS)

- face coverings will continue to be recommended
- limit on social gatherings will be relaxed to a 50-person maximum.
- Phase II will also carry a stay-at-home directive for vulnerable populations.
- continue to encourage physical distancing requirements to the extent possible
- telework (where doing so does not impose undue hardship), and face masks for employees.

PHASE III

- The ban on social gatherings will be lifted;
- There will no longer be a capacity limit on any business establishment (e.g., movie theaters, concert venues, and sports stadiums and arenas);
- Vulnerable populations will follow the general population in shifting from a stay-at-home directive to a safer-at-home directive;
- Businesses will be expected to continue their heightened cleaning measures such as enhancing their sanitizing practices on common surfaces.
